

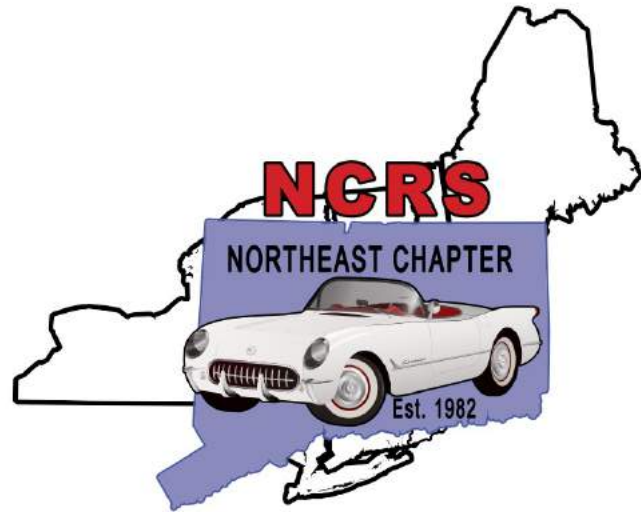

  - i. Discussed vote count results of the 2020 Board elections:

  - i. 2020 profit due to cancelled events.
- e. **Judging Report – Dave Brigham.**
  - i. Judging challenges are all related to COVID-19.
  - ii. Had to relax judging requirements where needed.
  - iii. Doing mini-events before the Heartland and Arizona events.
- f. **Membership – Marilyn Heitzman.**
  - i. Marilyn asked if she could extend the 14-month membership offer.
    1. Approved by the Board.
  - ii. Convention and Road Tour registration opens on February 1, 2021.
- g. **Merchandise Sales – David King.**
  - i. Sales are picking up.
    1. Currently back to pre-Covid-19 levels.
- h. **Road Tour Report – Joe SantaMaria.**
  - i. Mike Ingham thanked Joe for assuming the Road Tour responsibility.
- i. **Restorer and Driveline – Vinnie Peters.**
  - i. Vinnie continues to be impressed with the quantity and quality of Restorer contributions from members.
- j. **Publications – Mike Ingham.**
  - i. Vinnie Peters does a great job with The Restorer and The Driveline.
- k. **National Sponsorship – Mike Ingham for Carlton Colclough (Not Attending).**
  - i. Discussion about whether there is a budget for advertising.
    1. Currently budgeted \$3,000-\$4,000 per year for miscellaneous advertising expenses.
    2. Mike will ask Carlton to put together a proposal for advertising and an estimated budget for the Board.
- l. **Website/IT – Mike Ingham for John Waggoner (Not Attending).**
  - i. Discussion about a document which defines permissions for Chapter officers to change online data.
    1. Concerns expressed by multiple Chapters that permissions may be too restrictive.
- m. **Social Media Update – Shannon Urton.**
  - i. Two new administrators added.
  - ii. Discussion regarding potential use of podcasts.

### 4. Activities – Mike Ingham.

- a. Mike presented a proposal to move two Regionals and the National Convention out approximately two months.
  - i. Arizona Regional – To July 12-17 (including Mini-Meet).
  - ii. Heartland Regional – To August 2-7 (including Mini-Meet).
  - iii. Palm Springs, CA National Convention – To September 18-24.
- b. Discussion of overall health outlook for the pandemic.

- i. Concern that moving events out approximately 2 months would not make enough difference to justify the additional costs and effort to reschedule these events.
    - c. *Shannon Urton moved, and Bob Johansen seconded, to keep the 2021 Heartland Regional, Arizona Regional, and National Convention on their original, currently advertised schedule.*
      - i. *Passed: 5 for (Coker, Johansen, Ledgerwood, Ridge, Urton), 3 against (Ballard, Strawmyre, Tulley), 1 abstained (Ingham).*
- 5. Activities – Regional Events Proposal for 2023 – Mike Ingham.**
  - a. Reviewed the Regional event schedule for 2023.
- 6. Activities – National Conventions – Mike Ingham.**
  - a. Mike described a virtual visit to Albuquerque, NM, which is a potential future National Convention site.
- 7. Old Business.**
  - a. **Review and update General Board Meeting Action List – Larry Colvin.**
    - i. Reviewed and updated items on the General Board Meeting Action List.
- 8. New Business.**
  - a. **Discuss Proposed Update to NCRS COVID-19 Rules - Mike Ingham, Shannon Urton.**
    - i. Removed the requirement for use of gloves at NCRS events.
    - ii. Shannon Urton emphasized that people arriving at NCRS events who may be medically authorized to not wear masks will not be admitted to the event. ALL attendees at NCRS events MUST wear masks.
  - b. **2021 Chapter Top Flight Award Program – Bob Johansen.**
    - i. 2019 Chapter Top Flight awards will be presented at the next National Convention.
    - ii. Zoom Chapter meetings qualify as Chapter Top Flight events.
    - iii. Bob to consider whether 2021 program could be relaxed and come back to Board with recommendation.

  - ii. May 19, 2022 – May 21, 2022.
  - iii. Will be a feeder event for the Mobile, AL National Convention.
  - iv. *Dave Ewan moved, and Mike Ingham seconded, to approve a May 2022 Regional in Greenville, SC.*
    1. *Passed: 8 for, none against, 1 absent (Sue Strawmyre).*

- d. 2024 Options:

- vii. Make NCRS cars-for-sale information available via social media.

  - 3. Dave suggested contacting Gary Chesnut to start this process.
- ix. Shannon recommended involving a social-media knowledgeable person to coordinate and implement this program.
- x. Mike Ingham noted that a member of the Southern California Chapter makes short technical YouTube videos.
- xi. Shannon would like to put a social media update in The Driveline but wait until more changes have been made.
